## Children Under the Age of 16

The Services are not intended for children under 16 years of age. No one under age 16 may provide any information to the Services. #### **How We Collect Information About You**

We collect information about you:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us;
- Automatically as you navigate through the Services;
- From third parties, for example, our business partners; and
- From internet service providers, data analytic providers, operating systems, and social networks.

#### Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect on or through the Services may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on the Services. This includes information
  provided at the time of registration, subscribing to the Services, posting material, or
  requesting further services. We may also ask you for information when you report a
  problem with the Services.
- Records and copies of your correspondence including without limitation email addresses,
   if you contact us.

### **Sharing Personal Information**

- To third parties to market their products or services to you if you have consented to or not opted out of these disclosures.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it. For example, if you give us an email address to use the "email a friend" feature of our Services, we will transmit the contents of that email and your email address to the recipients.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our terms of use https://TheSoulMedic.com/TermsOfService and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.

• If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect our rights, property, or the safety of our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

# **Reselling Personal Information**

- 7. Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with consumer expectations based on your relationship with us.

- 8. Comply with a legal obligation.
- 9. Make other internal and lawful uses of that information that are compatible with the context in which you provided it.

We will delete or de-identify personal information not subject to one of these exceptions from our records and will direct our service providers to take similar action.

We do not provide these deletion rights for B2B personal information.

## Exercising Your Rights to Know or Delete

You do not need to create an account with us to submit a request to know or delete. However, we do consider requests made through your password-protected account sufficiently verified when the request relates to personal information associated with that specific account.

We will only use personal information provided in the request to verify the requestor's identity or authority to make it.

# Response Timing and Format

We endeavor to substantively respond to a verifiable consumer request within forty-five (45) days of its receipt. If we require more time (up to another 45 days), we will inform you of the reason and extension period in writing.

If you have an account with us, we will deliver our written response to that account. If you do not have an account with us, we will deliver our written response by mail or electronically, at your option.

Any disclosures we provide will only cover the 12-month period preceding our receipt of your request. The response we provide will also explain the reasons we cannot comply with a request, if applicable. For data portability requests, we will select a format to provide your personal information that is readily useable and should allow you to transmit the information from one entity to another entity without hindrance.

We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your verifiable consumer request unless it is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded. ### Personal Information Sales Opt-Out and Opt-In Rights
